



# San Martino di Castrozza

## resort information

This area is ideal for winter activities: from downhill skiing to snowboarding, ski-mountaineering and snowshoeing. Top-quality services and programmed snow systems make it possible to ski all season round. The lifts can be easily reached by the ski bus that links all the resorts. Given its position, this ski area boasts well-packed runs, fast lifts, guaranteed snow and excellent exposure to sun.

**The Ski Area San Martino di Castrozza**, Passo Rolle and Primiero is one of the 12 different ski areas in the huge Dolomiti Superski carousel. San Martino boasts over 60 km of slopes between 1,404 m and 2,357m, served by 25 ski lifts; one cable car, 2 automatic coupling cabin lifts, 15 chairlifts and 7 drag lifts. The carrying capacity is almost 3,000 people per hour. Waiting times are very short thanks to recent renovation of the ski lifts 95% of the ski area is always in excellent skiing condition, guaranteed by advanced artificial snowmaking facilities.

### **Town: San Martino di Castrozza (1450 mts a.s.l.)**

San Martino di Castrozza has preserved all the spirit and charm of an elegant and lively “Alpine capital”. Nestling in a wide plain covered in meadows and surrounded by thick conifer woods, the Alpine resort is dominated by the Pale di San Martino range, a group of bizarre and fantastic peaks that has inspired thousands of legends.



A winter holiday in San Martino offers the exhilarating emotions guaranteed by **skiing and snow**, as well as shopping opportunities, great fun in the typical inns and restaurants and all the events you can find in any lively and cosmopolitan city.

**The wonderful landscape** of the imposing Dolomites, the charming and well-coming ski-resorts of the valley wait for all the guest looking for an incredible holiday immersed in the nature and in the winter landscape. Not only alpine ski: nordic ski, nordic walking, snowshoes and ski touring led by expert instructors through paths, slopes and woods surrounded by the wonderful landscape of the Paneveggio Natural Park.

### **On the Slopes “Colverde”**

The attractive red Colverde run is 2 km long and is served by a fast gondola starting directly from the centre of San Martino. Here you can ski till late evening.

The run winds through a striking wood right under the Pale range.

The Col Verde alpine lodge is upstream the lit trail and is the ideal place to enjoy the typical products

or a warm glass of punch before the descent.

### **Cross country skiing**

Nature, snow and stress free physical activity are the passwords for this time-honored winter sport. In Trentino you will find hundreds of kilometers of perfectly groomed trails. Nordic skiing will turn your holiday on the snow into a unique opportunity to recuperate your fitness and eliminate the toxins produced by stress. It is the miracle of cross-country, a soft aerobic physical activity that will regenerate your body and mind as you ski along the tracks of Olympic champions.

### **Snowshoeing**

Freedom on the snow when snowshoeing. Walking without any impediments, as the old woodcutters used to do when they were working in the forests on the mountains in winter. There are no limits to this physical activity; you can snowshoe throughout the length and breadth of Trentino and it is really and truly suitable for everyone.

### **Ski touring**

Ski touring, climbing with skins attached to your skis and then descending long slopes in fresh snow, is perhaps the most exciting sports discipline. An activity that permits you to discover the attractions of the country in winter, far from the noise and crowds of the pistes. Skiing in freedom amidst nature.

### **Passo Rolle**

An excursion to the Passo Rolle is well worth it. This family friendly skiing resort extends along the confines of the Paneveggio forest. It's the green heart of the Nature Park and has been named the 'forest of the violins', because the finest instruments were already being fashioned there hundreds of years ago from the best available wood. From the Segantini rifugio the view is wonderful to the rock mass of the Cimon della Pala.

**The 'Tognola Uno'** run towards Malga Fratazza is one of the longest and most beautiful in the entire Dolomites. After the transfer to the ski-bus on the Col Verde we come to a high point in the tour. With the cable car we swing on and up to the 'rifugio' and yet further to the 2,600 metre high Cima Rosetta.

Far removed from the hurly-burly, a breathtaking panoramic view opens itself out before your eyes over the high plateau of the Pala Group, over to Cimon della Pala, and to Marmolada too. Rocks, snow, sun and nature as far as the eye can reach. It's simply unforgettable ! After a day in the Nature Park we make the closing trip to San Martino. The sun seems to hang in the air here for a long time, creating a special alpine twilight.

With a nice glass of wine by your side you'll be able to eavesdrop on the local folk's stories and legends which are woven around the giant stony monuments that are the Pala Group.

### **Snowboarding lovers can enjoy two snowparks:**

San Martino Snowpark and Rolle Railz Park.

The former is located on the runs of San Martino di Castrozza; around this snowpark you will find lots of good music, nice people and a refreshment point!

While the latter is situated at Passo Rolle near Capanna Cervino, where you can enjoy a rest in a warm atmosphere after doing acrobatics with your board. Both parks boast specialised facilities (jumps, rails, boxes, wallrides, boardercross, and much more) suitable for beginners and skilled snowboarders alike. A professional staff directly sees to the realisation and maintenance of the parks.

## Travel by car

### Route 1.

From the Brennero/Modena motorway (A22) take the Egna/Oroa exit and proceed along the Dolomite national road (S.S. 48) in the direction of Cavalese till Predazzo. Follow then the national road S.S. 50 to Passo Rolle, San Martino di Castrozza and Primiero.

### Route 2.

From the Brennero/Modena motorway (A22) exit at Trento Nord, then take the Valsugana national road S.S. 47 (direction Bassano/Padova) till Primolano. Follow the national road 50bis (direction Feltre/Belluno) till Arten. Take then the national road S.S. 50 to Primiero, San Martino di Castrozza and Passo Rolle.

### Route 3.

From the Torino/Trieste motorway (A4) continue to Vicenza and take then the Vicenza-Valdastico motorway (A31) exit Dueville. Proceed along the Valsugana national road (S.S. 47) direction Bassano/Trento.

Heading northwards from S.S.47, shortly after Cismon del Grappa, take S.S.50 following the signs to Primiero, San Martino di Castrozza and Passo Rolle (S.S. 50bis)

## Ski pass San Martino Di Castrozza

San Martino / Passo Rolle Ski pass

Ski runs for over more than 60 km, at between 1,404 and 2,357 m altitude, within a unique natural landscape, covering every difficulty grades, with exciting routes accessible to beginners and thrilling to expert skiers. In total there are 24 ski-lift facilities in operation.

To ski on the Carosello delle Malghe (45 km of runs in the charming areas of Tognola, Valcigolera and Ces), on Colverde and Passo Rolle you can either use the valley ski pass or the Dolomiti Superski pass.
